

CGPACS 2016 Faculty Seed Grant Opportunity (Seed Grants Available to CGPACS Faculty Affiliates Only)

The Center for Global Peace and Conflict Studies at UCI is pleased to offer seed grants for projects relevant to the Center's mission and interests. The Center will support collaborative projects involving groups of UCI faculty (including research conferences or workshops held at UCI); we will also support individual or joint faculty research projects. Faculty may apply for up to **\$1500** in seed grant funding. PLEASE NOTE THAT DUE TO BUDGETARY CONSTRAINTS, WE WILL FUND FEWER GRANTS THIS YEAR.

The mission of CGPACS is to promote innovative research on international problems and processes. We welcome proposals that concern the military/ strategic, economic/ environmental, or cultural/ normative motives, processes, and consequences of either peace or conflict. We will give priority to faculty whose projects a) represent new synergies in work on global peace and conflict, and/or b) have not been previously funded by CGPACS (or not recently funded by CGPACS. All projects must address a problem that has transnational, international, or global implications for peace and conflict and state the implications in the proposal narrative.

The deadline for submission of proposals is **FEBRUARY 28, 2016**. Funding decisions will be made no later than April 15, 2016.
